Technical Tours ... Witness Technology in Action!
Sunday, May 9

A: Control Centres Tour

Each tour limited to 10 people / Duration: 3 hours

Transportation will be provided from the Hyatt to the Calgary Transit Control Centre, and on to the CP Rail Control Centre. Once the second tour is complete, participants will walk the short distance back to the Hyatt.

Calgary Transit – Operations Control Centre

Calgary Transit's Operations Control Centre (OCC) oversees the operation of the buses and light rail transit. The OCC also provides security monitoring of the LRT Stations as well as customer services via Closed Circuit Television, Help Phones and Public Address Systems.

CP Rail Control Centre

Canadian Pacific Railway's Network Management centre dispatches and coordinates all of CPR's Western Canada Railway Traffic. In addition, the Signals and Communication Support desk monitors the continent-wide communication system and Train Traffic Control System (CTC-Central Train Control) and manages the field troubleshooting activity.

B: University of Calgary Driving Simulator Tour

Each tour limited to 8 people / Duration: 90 minutes

A guide will take you from the Hyatt to the University via the C-Train (Calgary's Light Rapid Transit) and back. Short walks are required between the facilities and the C-Train Stations.

The University of Calgary Driving Simulator (UCDS) is a high-fidelity simulator that is being used to investigate basic and applied research in in-vehicle ITS and traffic safety. Time permitting, visitors will be shown ongoing research projects and allowed to briefly drive the UCDS.
