## NOMINATION OF XIN CHEN FOR THE ITS CANADA YOUNG PROFESSIONAL AWARD

The present letter is in support of the nomination of Xin Chen for the ITS Canada Young Professional Award.

In the three years that I've known Xin and directly working with him I have had a chance to monitor his rapid development as an ITS Professional and to watch him reaching a level of maturity as an engineer that is well beyond what would be expected for someone of his age (he is 28 years old).

Xin is currently coordinating ITS design for a few of the most complex and demanding P3 projects in North America, including:

- The Gordie Howe International Bridge: a new cable-stayed 6-lane Bridge between Windsor and Detroit, serving more than 30% of all goods carried by truck between Canada and the United States, delivered through a \$5.7 billion 30-year P3 contract. As a subcontractor to AECOM, IBI Group is the designer for the ITS, Tolling, Communications and Security Systems for the Bridge, the Canadian Point of Entry and the USA Point of Entry. Xin has been the Technical Coordinator of the design of these systems. His day-to-day work for the project includes the coordination with a number of other design disciplines, the construction contractor and its subcontractors, the Windsor-Detroit Bridge Authority and agencies, including MTO, MDOT, CBSA, CBP among others; and
- The Yonge North and Scarborough Subway Extensions in Toronto: IBI Group is the Technical Advisor to Infrastructure Ontario (IO) and Metrolinx on the Scarborough and Yonge North Subway Extension projects, as part of the OneT+ joint venture with Gannett Fleming. The Scarborough Subway Extension is a 7.8-km extension of Line 2 (Bloor-Danforth) from the existing Kennedy station. The Yonge North Subway Extension is a cross-jurisdictional project that will extend the existing north line by 7km. Xin is coordinating the ITS technical requirements with other disciplines, the client and stakeholders (including TTC, GO Transit and YRT).

Xin is capable of working at different levels and coordinating large multidisciplinary teams. He is versatile, having worked in a variety of assignments, ranging from traffic modelling to detailed systems engineering and thus has a holistic view of the broader transportation systems design and implementation, the issues or risks that might arise and how to resolve them. His recent transportation planning and modelling work includes traffic signal coordination for McCowan Road, Dundas Street, Danforth Avenue, and Warden Avenue in Toronto, rehabilitation modelling for the QEW / Highway 403 and traffic modelling for the Hurontario LRT. He does not hesitate to
