



## Getting from Vancouver to Whistler

After consulting with several knowledgeable folks in Whistler, the following summarizes options available.

### 1. **By Bus** – Perimeter Transportation ([www.perimeterbus.com](http://www.perimeterbus.com))

They operate WHISTLER EXPRESS BUS SERVICE, the official shuttle service between the Vancouver International Airport and Whistler. They provide direct service to all major hotels and the other lodging situated at the base of Whistler/Blackcomb Mountain. They also provide door-to-door service with key pick-up for more remote condominiums and private chalets. Some departures from the airport and pick-up at various Vancouver Hotels. They are the easiest way to travel for conference delegates who are heading up to Whistler.

### 2. **By Charter Van or Mini-Bus**

PERIMETER TRANSPORTATION operates a full service Private Charter Division with a fleet of vans, mini-buses and motor coaches. They are licensed for pick-up at the Vancouver International Airport, anywhere in Greater Vancouver, Whistler or Seattle. Private transfers are well suited for families or larger groups.

### 3. **By Rail** ([www.whistlermountaineer.com](http://www.whistlermountaineer.com))

A three-hour rail excursion between North Vancouver and Whistler, with daily service in both directions and world-class Western Canadian hospitality onboard. The route delivers the unique blend of contrasts the Sea-to-Sky region is famous for: cities and old-growth forests, bustling action and natural serenity, deep valleys and snow-capped peaks, seascapes and mountain views.

### 4. **By Limousine**

There are several limousine services that travel regularly between the Vancouver International Airport and Whistler Village. We recommend that you contact the concierge at the Fairmont Chateau Whistler (e-mail: [concierge.chateauwhistler@fairmont.com](mailto:concierge.chateauwhistler@fairmont.com)) to make arrangements for limousine pick-ups.

### 5. **By Rental Vehicle**

There are numerous rental agencies at the Vancouver International Airport and they can provide cars, vans and SUVs.
