Steve Buckley serves as the General Manager for Transportation Services for the City of Toronto. In that capacity, Steve oversees 1,100 dedicated civil servants and roughly \$12 billion in transportation assets. Since coming to Toronto, Steve has overseen a number of new and exciting technological initiatives including the deployment of the Toronto Cycling App, a research study with McMaster University using probe data to study congestion in Toronto and the creation of the Big Data Innovation Team. Prior to joining Toronto, Steve was the Director of Policy and Planning for the Deputy Mayor in Philadelphia, while also serving as Deputy Commissioner for Transportation in the Philadelphia Streets Department. Steve is an active member of the Transportation Research Board, the National Association of City Transportation Officials, the Transport Association of Canada, and currently serves as a Board member for the Intelligent Transportation Society of Canada.
