Entries are invited for the 2017 ITS Canada Student Essay Awards. The awards are set up to encourage student interest and participation in the development of Intelligent transport technologies.

Write an essay on the topic of:

“Integrated Mobility in Smart Cities”

The awards will be for the best three essays of between a 1000 and 1250 words in length. The eligibility requirements are as follows; open to Canadian citizens and permanent residents who are undergraduate and/or graduate students and enrolled at a Canadian university in a program related to intelligent transportation. Marks will be awarded for knowledge of new and developing technologies, for innovative ideas, and for good presentation and style.

The prizes

The “Gold” winner receives a cash price of \$1000, the “Silver” winner \$750 and the “Bronze” winner \$500 and an opportunity to present their work at the 24th ITS WC 2017 Oct 29 – Nov 2, 2017 Montreal in a poster session in the ITS Canada Pavilion.
