- Abstract proposals can be made via the submission portal below.
- Abstracts submitted by email will not be accepted.
- Any use of Al tools to generate text, images or graphics in your abstract, or to collect, generate or analyse data, must be described in the abstract submission. The tool used must be named and its application described. Authors are responsible for validating the information generated and providing full citations. Avoiding plagiarism remains the responsibility of the author. Al bots such as ChatGPT shall not be acknowledged as authors.
- Attendance and presentation options at ITS Canada 2026 are in-person only.
- Commercially driven proposals will not be considered.
- All session speakers, moderators and paper presenters will be required to register and pay the appropriate registration fee.
- Presentation slots require registration and payment by the deadline; otherwise, they may be reassigned.
- Travel and accommodation costs are the responsibility of all accepted participants.
